**While the majority of the tuition costs will be subsidized by the Fremont Street Fund, each school team will be required to pay \$2,200 per semester (\$4,400 total)**

- **The in-person sessions will be held at Rutgers University.**
- **Dates for future in-person sessions will be determined in collaboration with participating teams based on their availability.**
- **In addition to the in-person sessions, schools will be required to participate in 1 hour-long phone or virtual check-in per semester.**
- **We will also ask school teams to complete 1 to 2 brief surveys per semester about their experience in the program.**
